

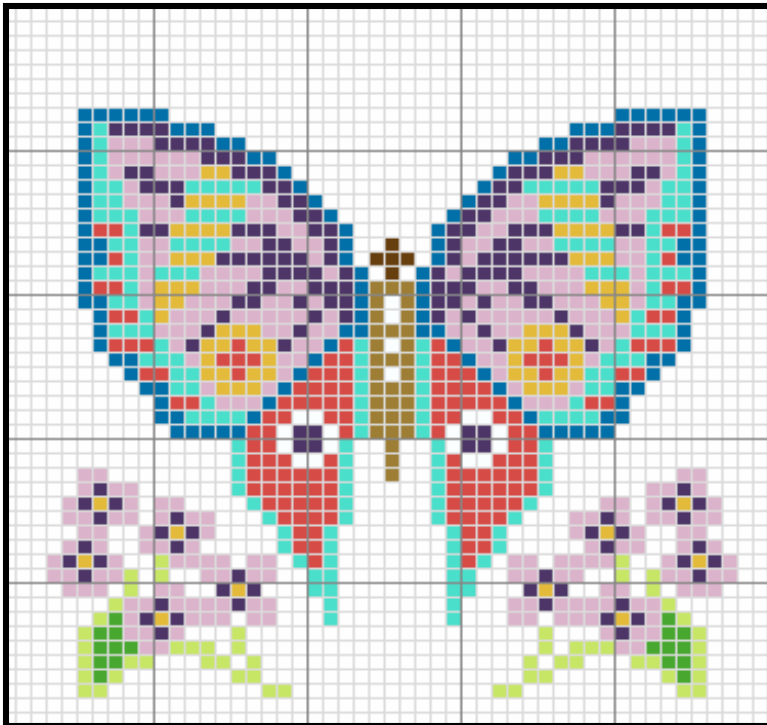


Flying 3D Butterfly

DMC *Color Infusions* Memory Thread



DMC's Stitch-opoly Property Card

Materials Needed:

- 14 count Aida, DMC Blanc 2 pieces:
5" x 5" piece to stitch butterfly,
9" x 9" for background and to anchor butterfly
- Size 24 DMC Embroidery Needle
- Size 20 DMC Tapestry Needle
- DMC threads as noted on chart

Design size:

Grid Size: 50W x 50H

Design Area: 3.21" x 2.93"
(45 x 41 stitches)

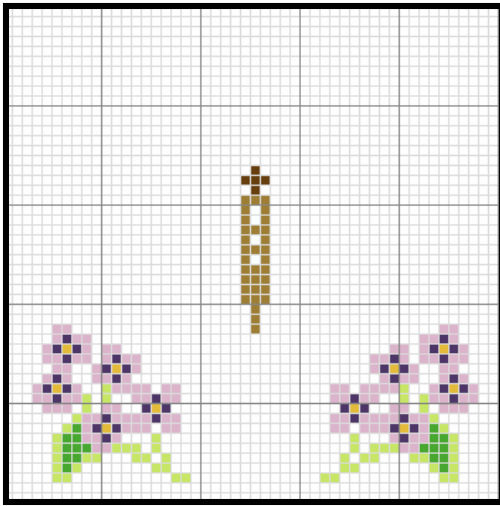


Chart 1A

Stitch on 9" x 9" piece of DMC 14 ct Aida

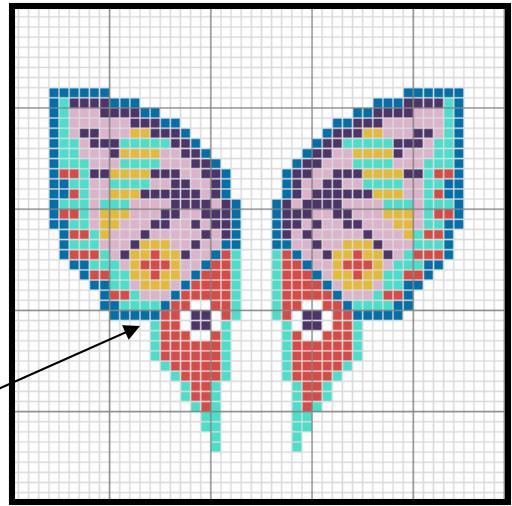


Chart 1B

Stitch on 5" x 5" piece of DMC 14 ct Aida

1. Mark center of 9"x 9" piece of Aida and stitch **only background flowers**, and NOT the body or head on chart 1A , as per thread specified on the chart.
2. On smaller 5"x 5" piece of Aida, stitch **only the two wings** of the butterfly, as per thread specified on chart 1B.
3. Determine a continuous path of the **Memory Thread** to outline the butterfly wings as shown in photograph. Cut a 14" length of Turquoise **Memory Thread** 6110 for each wing.
4. With the size 20 Tapestry needle, enlarge the hole where you will begin adding the **Memory Thread**, as Indicated in chart 1B.
5. Push the end of the **Memory Thread** through the hole from the front to the back and turn the end back about ½" on the back side of the butterfly.
6. Using one strand of DMC 3846 threaded on a small embroidery needle, tack down the end of the **Memory Thread** to the back.
7. Following the outside edge of the area to be outlined, tack down the **Memory Thread** every ½" or so. Use your fingers to shape the **Memory Thread** to the outline.
8. When you get to the ending point, enlarge a hole with the size 20 Tapestry needle and push the end of the **Memory Thread** to the back side, turn it and tack the end down on the back side. Clip any extra **Memory Thread**.
9. Repeat steps 3 to 8 and outline on the other butterfly wing.
10. Trim away the excess Aida Cloth around the butterfly, leaving a ½" edge to turn under.
11. Turn under the edge of Aida and tack down on the back side. Clip Aida as needed to get the curves to turn nicely.
12. Once both wings are trimmed and turned, locate where wings should be placed on the larger background piece of Aida, as per Chart 1A. Line up the center points and pin butterfly wings in place.
13. Stitch body of butterfly by going through Aida for butterfly wings and the background.
14. Stitch the head of the butterfly using 6 strands of floss on the background fabric.
15. To create the antennae, cut a 10" piece of Brown **Memory Thread** 6010 and pull through either side of butterfly head. Center thread so the ends are even and tack down on back side.
16. Curl ends of **Memory Thread** antennae on a pencil, trim and shape as desired.
