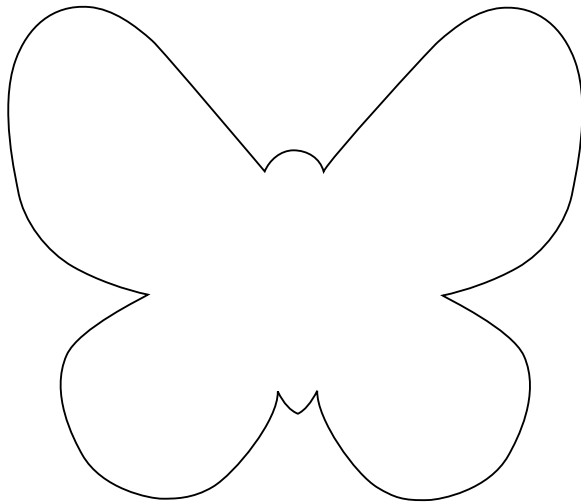
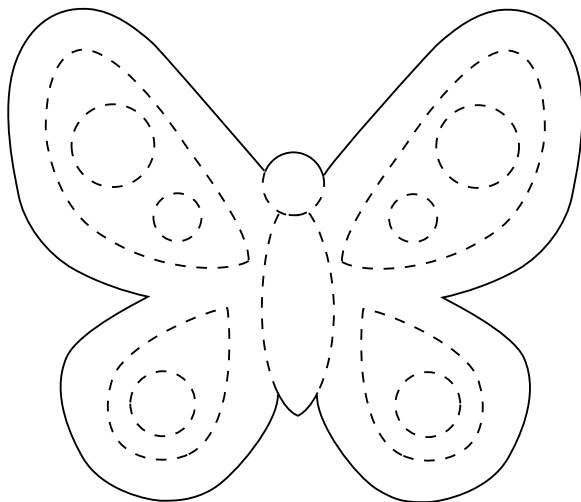


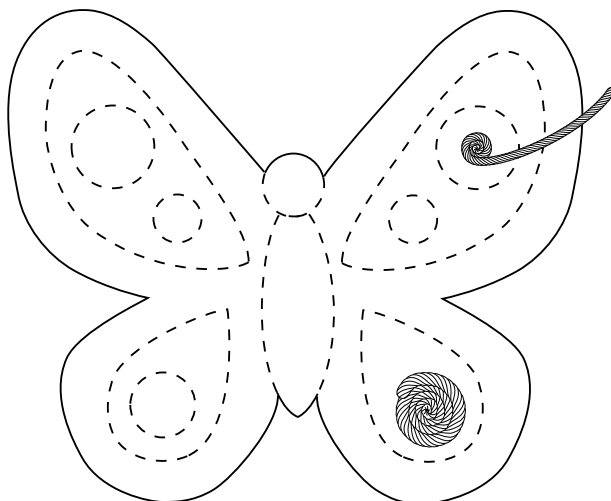
# PRISM WRAPPED-THREAD ORNAMENTS



Blank Wood Form



Draw Details with Pencil



Fill Shapes with Thread

## MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Assorted colors of Prism Craft Thread
- Pre-cut wood ornaments or shapes
- Pencil
- Tacky glue
- Toothpicks
- Scissors
- Waxed paper
- Baking sheet

## DIRECTIONS:

Line the baking sheet with the waxed paper. This will make the shapes easier to move as they dry, and protect your work surface from the glue.

Using the pencil, lightly mark the desired shapes on the front of the wood ornament. These shapes will be filled with the colored thread.

Working with one marked area at a time, apply a thin layer of glue inside the marked lines.

Fill the shape by wrapping or spiraling the Prism Craft Thread inside the shape, adhering it in the glue. Use toothpicks to hold it in place to keep your fingers clean and to prevent sticky fingers from pulling the thread off the ornament as you work. Replace the toothpick often to keep it from sticking too.

After gluing the thread over the entire ornament, allow the ornament to dry completely.

Glue a length of thread around the outside edges of each ornament.

Cut a 6-inch length of thread and fold it in half to form a loop. Glue the loop to the top, back side of the ornament for hanging.
